Salt of the Earth (SOTE)

SOTE has been working in partnership with SCAD and supporting its work since SOTE was established as a registered charity in 1988. SOTE is run by volunteers, all of whom have spent time at SCAD, and have a personal commitment to its work. SOTE trustees make annual trips (at personal expense) to SCAD to discuss programme implementation, monitor progress and ensure that donated funds are well-spent. The relationship between SOTE and SCAD is based on the principles of mutual trust and respect.

Social Change and Development (SCAD)

SCAD is a non-governmental organisation that works in over 450 of the poorest villages in Tamil Nadu, India, focusing its efforts on the most disadvantaged sections of the community, including 'untouchables', gypsies, and saltpan workers. SCAD programmes include primary healthcare, education and vocational training, community development, water and sanitation, income generation, women's empowerment and organic sustainable agriculture which combines traditional methods with new technologies. SCAD also works with people with leprosy, abandoned elders and children with physical and learning difficulties.

With your help children born into villages in Tamil Nadu can have a real opportunity to break out of a cycle of illiteracy, poverty, debt and ill-health and so achieve their potential.

A community response to addressing poverty

Founded in 1985 Social Change and Development (SCAD) has been implementing a wide range of programmes in Tamil Nadu, India, assisting villagers in claiming their rights and in improving the quality of their lives.

A key aspect of SCAD's approach is to work with communities to find and implement sustainable solutions, that have a positive impact in the long term rather than only tackling immediate needs. Empowering the young and providing them with a chance to change the cycle of poverty is crucial in achieving this aim.

Tamil Nadu is the southern most state of India. Many of its population of over 66 million live below the poverty line and lack access to the very basics of human existence, clean water, quality healthcare, and education. Often families exist on less than £300 per year and are forced to travel several miles simply to collect water. Inevitably it is children who experience the greatest impact of such poverty. Many suffer from malnutrition, and acute, yet avoidable diseases, do not have the opportunity to learn the new skills necessary for employment or have an opportunity to get their voices heard.

Realising a child's potential and investing in the future

SCAD implements a holistic package which improves the standard of life for children at every level. This includes schooling and vocational skills-based training, natural nutritional supplements for children, as well as health education to parents and children.

Three years ago, Seethalaxmi, a malnourished six year-old girl, began the SCAD sponsorship scheme, through which she was restored to full health within a year. In addition, with the help of SCAD's grant and low-cost loans, her family has since built a stable brick home, and her village has been able to dig a new, much needed well.

This scheme supports children aged 5 - 12 living in particularly disadvantaged villages in Tamil Nadu. For a minimum of £12 per month you can change the life of such a child, and bring benefits to their whole family and community.

Many sponsors also exchange letters with their child.
